## FINAL JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION

On December 28, 2006 the parties entered into a Joint Stipulation which was confirmed by written Order on January 10, 2007. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Stipulation, this Court reviewed the constitutionality of Florida Statute 784.046, Florida's Stalking Statute. On January 16, 2007 this Court entered its Order finding that the statute is constitutional, both on its face and as applied to the Defendant under the stipulated facts in this cause.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Temporary Injunction entered by this court on August 26, 2003 is hereby deemed to be a Permanent Injunction. Accordingly:
- a. The Defendant shall refrain from coming within 1000 feet of the Plaintiffs' home, or their current or future principal places of business: currently, (a) 5858 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg, Florida 33707, and (b) 2600 9<sup>th</sup> Street North, St. Petersburg, Florida.
